



Within days of the shooting in Parkland, Florida, a movement emerged. *Never Again* was a response to the latest school shooting and a desire to prevent future tragedies. This movement resulted in the nationwide *March for our Lives* in Washington DC, a town hall meeting with President Trump, and companies changing their policies on age limits to purchase firearms. Through social media, *Never Again* found its voice and platform to affect change in what the country had hoped since Columbine: that this school shooting would be the last. What is extraordinary about this movement is that youth are leading it.

Youth have proven to be a powerful voice on issues that they care about. Whether they are involved in movements like *Never Again*, *Black Lives Matter*, *Disability Rights*, or *United We Dream*, youth are validating that they care about the future impact that social justice issues have in their community.
